

**Who Can Apply?** This program was started to recognize the generous support the Cobequid Health Centre Foundation received from our area high schools (listed below) during the building of the Cobequid Health Centre. The students from these schools fundraised and donated over \$80,000 to help make a health center for our community a reality.

At Cobequid Foundation we have never forgotten this generosity. So, we started this bursary program as way of saying thank you and giving back to our community.

Any Grade 12 student who attends one of the following high schools:

- Charles P. Allen High School
- Millwood High School
- Sackville High School
- Lockview High School

One bursary per school will be granted per year.

**What Are the Criteria?** You must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program related to the health/medical field. This includes both university and college programs. Due to need within the Cobequid Centre, the following programs are given special consideration:

- Medical Laboratory Technologist
- Physiotherapy Assistant
- EKG Technologist
- X-Ray Technologist
- Pharmacy Clerk
- Orthopedic Technician

**This does not mean these are the only students who should apply.** Do not count yourself out. In the past bursaries have been awarded to students pursuing Nursing, Continuing Care Assistant Program, Social Work, Health Sciences, Diagnostic Imaging (X-ray), Sports Medicine and Mental Health to name a few.

**What is the Value of Bursary?** The bursary is for \$1,000 towards the tuition of the first year of post-secondary education.
